- To create a community with stakeholders and end users
- Raise the level of trust in open standards

Role of Infracom

- Not to drive all the development
- Provide a framework within which the work is undertaken
- Ensure timely execution of work tasks by a diverse community of experts

Three types of project

- Formal bSI Standards Development Projects
- Preparatory Standards Development Work
- Short Term Working Groups

Formal bSI Standard Development Projects

- Endorsed and funded through bSI
- Current ifcAlignment is an example
- A variant is one where important development work has been undertaken outside formal bSI processes
 - A formal bSI project may be established to review, refine and propose adoption of that work

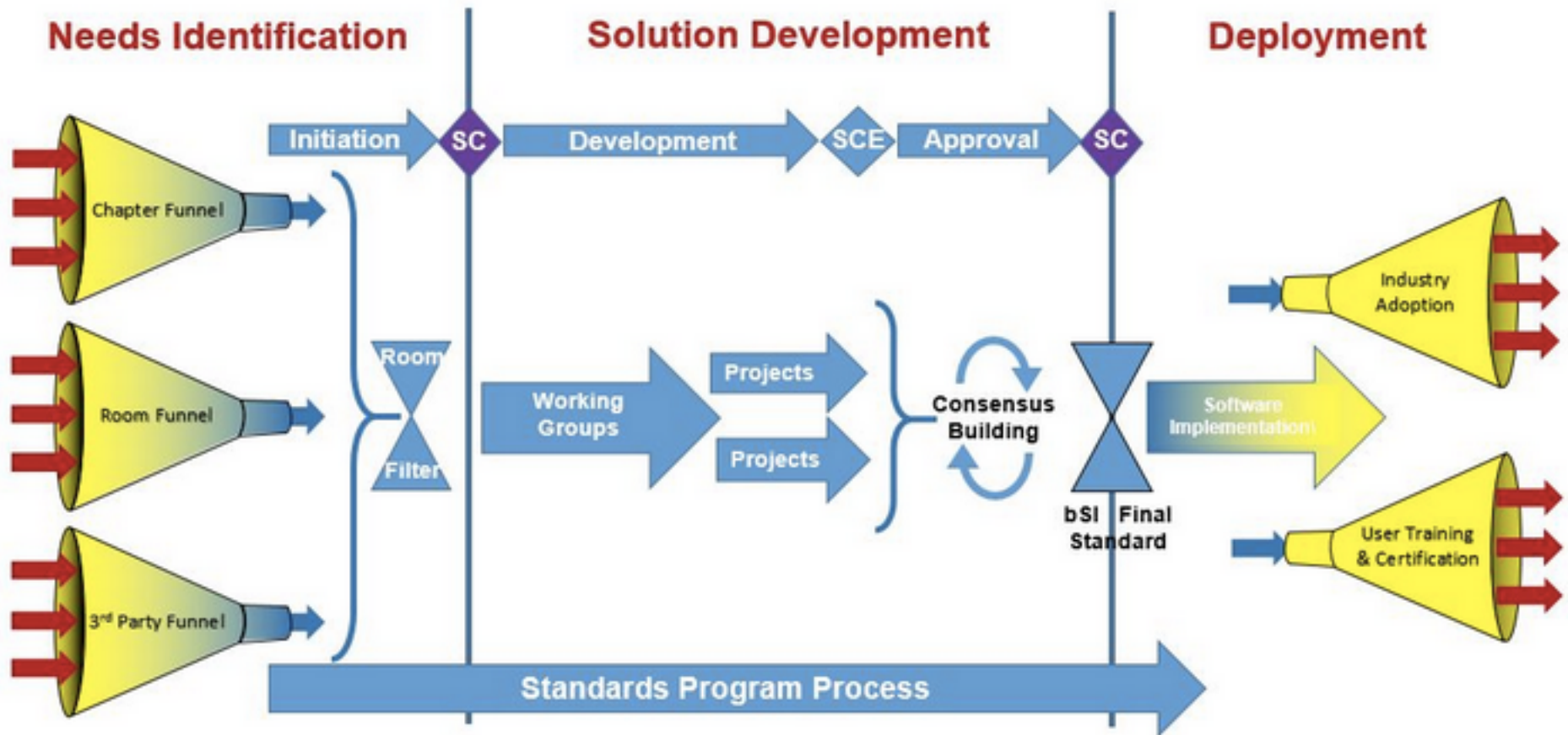
Preparatory Standards Development Work

- There is a perceived need for a standard, but a recognition that preparatory work is necessary
 - Identify existing work in the area
 - Develop a strategy for undertaken the development
 - Identify a team, work program and resources
- Result: a robust proposal

Short term working group

- Small expert panels, charged to a specific issue of relevance
- Produce a discussion paper with a set of recommendations for further considerations by the Infra Room community

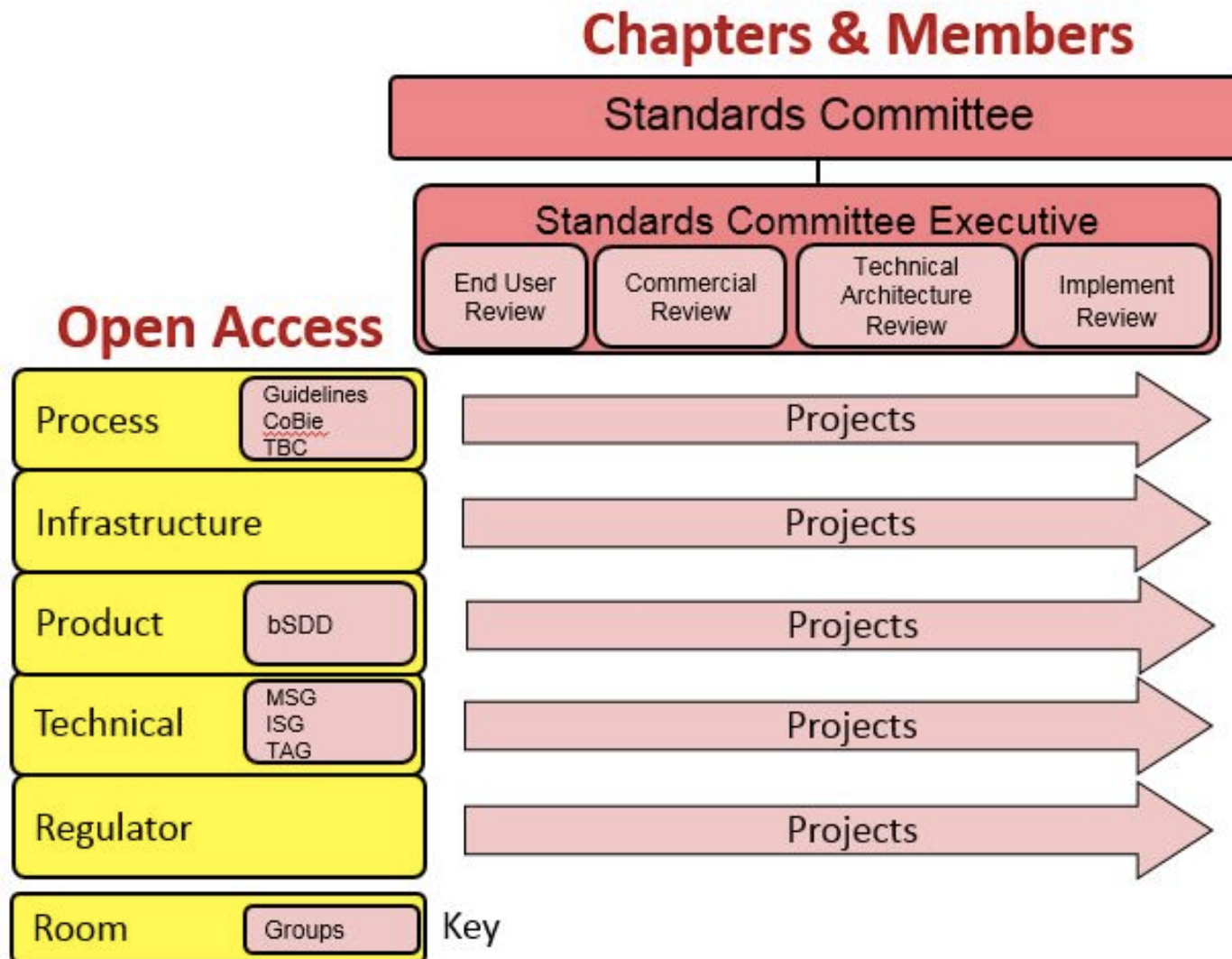

The Standards Committee is the senior governance body overseeing the standards process. It will comprise representatives from members and chapters according to the following list which may be updated from time to time by the bSI Executive after appropriate consultation:

Chapters (full): 2 votes (one user vote and one technical vote)

Chapters (in development): 1 vote

SAC Members: 2 votes

International Members: 1 vote

Standard Members: 1 vote
