Member Status

Major activities

Denmark

- Since July 1 2011 **all** public (not only state) projects with a total value of more than MDK 20 (M€ 3) have to follow the guidelines from the Digital Construction project - incl. handing in IFC models. Design of public housing/apartments with governmental added will be required to handle and hand in models from 2012.
- Dikon (largest engineering companies and contractors) is making IDMs related to QTO and consistency control.
- The Danish University and Property Agency (DUPA) had a very positive article in bips nyt regarding using models in IFC-format in competitions. Research report from the Technical University shows that companies are making profit from using IFC.

Finland

- The comments for revised COBIM BIM requirements have been submitted, the schedule is to finalize the Finnish versions by the end of the year. Later on, all the final documents will be translated into English as well.
- Activities around RYM project six work packages have continued.
- buildingSMART Finland organized a COBIM feedback seminar for members in the end of August.

Sweden

- Breakfast seminars every 6th week have been launched. First topics are FM deliveries, Quantity take off, Environmental product data and Energy analysis.
- IFD Library Group Sweden preparing for members to join the organization.

Priorities for summit

- Infrastructure – decide on Road Map
- Compatibility between IFC 2x3 and IFC 2x4 – agree on principles
- MVD development – the methodology and decision processes have to be formalized
